Our Charity

Please help us support this local charity by buying raffle tickets.

My name is Hannah from Willington, Derby. Despite being given 14 months when I was 19, I am now 21. I have brain cancer and rather than just give up, I have decided to make a difference and dedicate the rest of my life to helping other teenagers with cancer in the teenage cancer ward of Nottingham City hospital and beyond.

In April of this year, a charity was registered in my name, "Hannahs Hope" (Registered Charity number 1207733). The aim of the charity is to build a respite for other teenage cancer patients like myself.

The lodge will be located in beautiful, tranquil surroundings of Mercia Marina in the heart of Derbyshire. It offers peace to families at a devastating time, enabling memories to be made outside of a hospital environment & providing therapeutic treatments and counselling

I am extremely proud of this charity and I won the **BBC Make a Difference Award** in September last year. Since April, we have raised £163,000 towards the £203,000 target. This charity will give hope and support to teenagers and young adults aged 13-24 for which there are currently no provisions for respite. Teenage and young adult cancer, not only affects the patient, but has a devastating effect on the whole family. The aim of the charity is to offer support, joy and respite, with terminal cases taking priority.

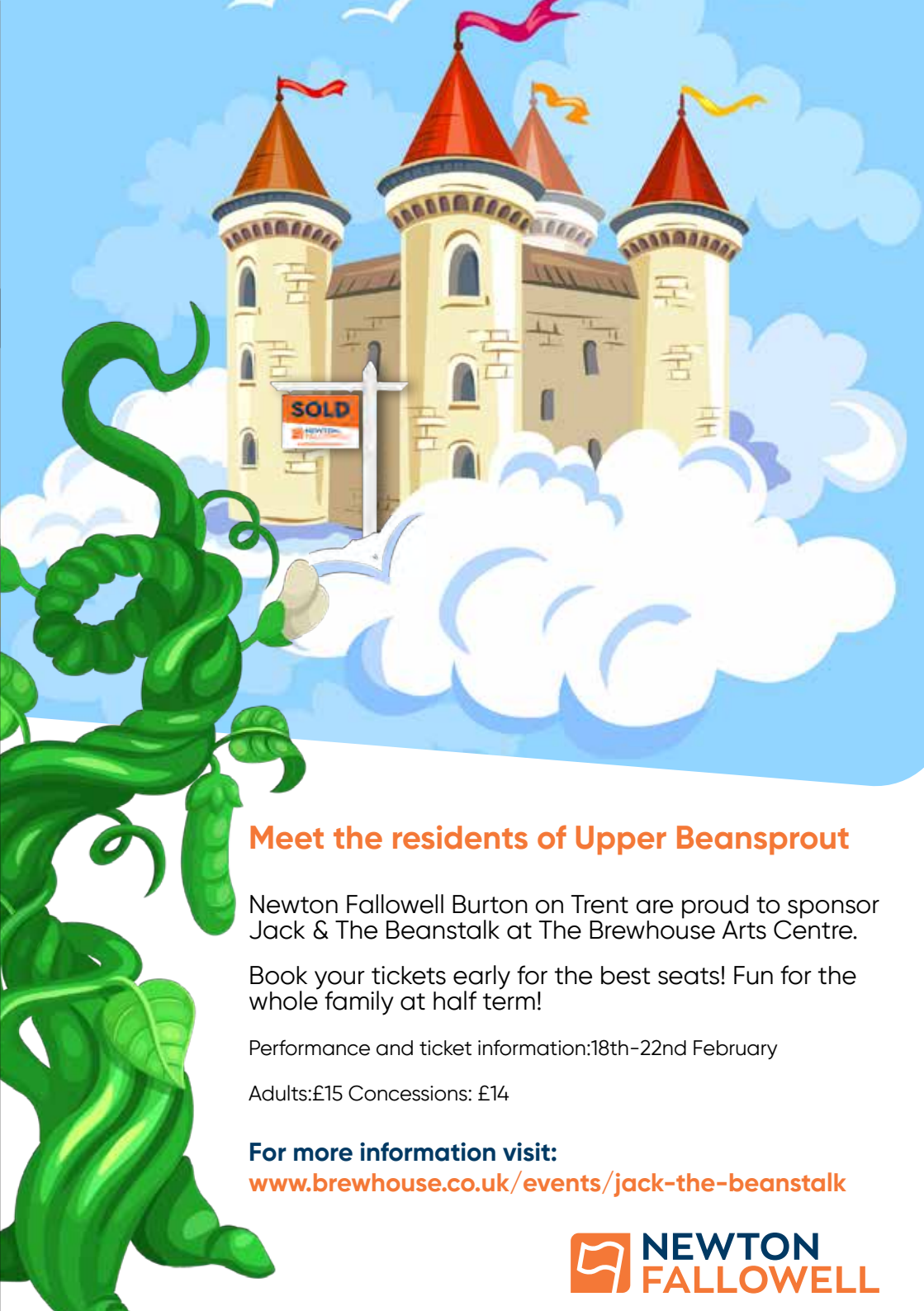

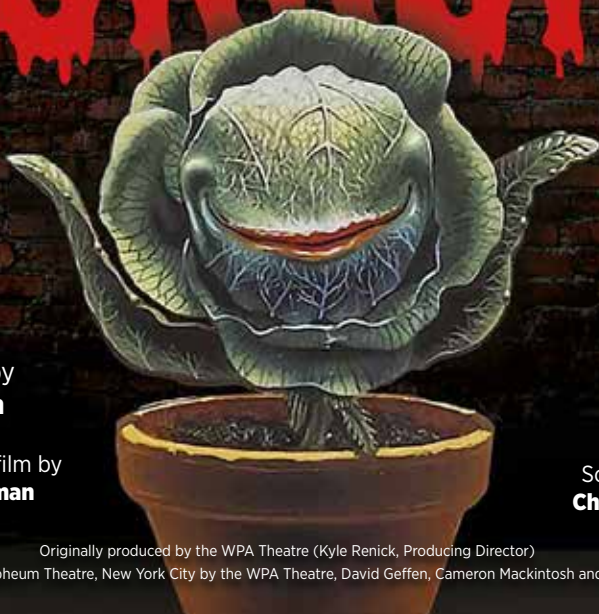

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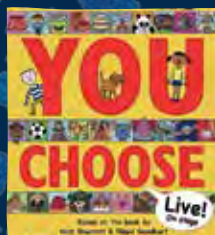
